\*\*\*Students must attend State Champs and the MC tournament in addition to the four in-state tournaments they are required to go to. Students who fail to meet their four in-state tournaments will not be asked back the following year OR be allowed to participate in Nationals/Banquet if they are seniors\*\*\*

#### FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENTS

- All students and parents must assist at (at minimum) one football parking event
- All students and parents must assist at least one concession shift for basketball
- Ad sales requirements are \$200 and must be met or the student will be required to audition for the team the next year---Ad sales will be due in November

# <u>Cost</u>

- \$315 dollars to cover the REGISTRATION COST of a student's first four tournaments, the national fees, t-shirts, etc... Due August 31st- Make out check to MC Speech and Debate Booster Club. If you need a payment plan, it must be set up by July 1st.
- Students must pay hotel fees at every tournament UNLESS the booster can alleviate fees
- Judge bonds are required until parents have judged four times. They are not required at tournaments where parents are judging or after the four required judging times. Judge bonds are \$30

## <u>Camp</u>

MC Speech and Debate will be holding camp in July. Please keep an eye on emails for more information. Camp is required unless discussed with Mrs. Clapper-Davis and proof of an important obligation stopping the student exists.

#### Student Responsibility

Students are expected to check student emails regularly for information from Ms. Clapper. The team also has a GroupMe Chat (for students) and a Remind101 (for parents). It is up to students to meet all requirements and keep up with all communication.

## After School Practice
